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

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<b>DEFINITIONS</b>	<b>ITEMS TO BE COMPLETED</b>
<p><b>Debtor</b> The person, corporation, or other entity that has filed a bankruptcy case is called the debtor.</p> <p><b>Creditor</b> A creditor is any person, corporation, or other entity to which the debtor owed a debt.</p> <p><b>Proof of Claim</b> A form filed with the clerk of the bankruptcy court where the bankruptcy case was filed, to tell the bankruptcy court how much the debtor owed a creditor (the amount of the creditor's claim).</p>	<p><b>Information about Creditor:</b> Complete the section giving the name and address of the creditor that was listed on the previously filed Proof of Claim form.</p> <p><b>Information identifying the Claim that is to be withdrawn:</b> Complete the section giving the court claim number, date claim was filed and total amount of claim filed to help identify the claim that is to be withdrawn.</p> <p><b>Sign and print the name and title, if any of the creditor or other person authorized to file this withdrawal of claim (attach copy of power of attorney, if any.)</b></p>
