Dear Judge Carey:

I write to you as counsel to Exide Technologies (the “Debtor”) in connection with the Request of the Official Committee (the “Committee”) of Unsecured Creditors for a Status Conference Pursuant to Section 105(d) of the Bankruptcy Code filed yesterday (Docket No. 1739).

Prior to filing their request, we informed Committee counsel that the Debtor would fully support a status conference and asked counsel to contact chambers in lieu of filing an unnecessary pleading. Unfortunately, the Committee felt compelled to file a pleading regarding an otherwise consensual request. Nevertheless, the Debtor remains supportive of a status conference. We respectfully suggest that representatives of other key stakeholders, namely the unofficial committee of senior secured noteholders, the agent for the Debtor’s debtor-in-possession financing facility, the indenture trustee for the Debtor’s senior secured notes, and the United States Trustee be invited to participate. We also would request that the conference

take place in chambers or a sealed courtroom to allow for discussion of potentially commercially sensitive information. If the Court is so inclined, the Debtor will notify the appropriate persons of the conference.
