**ORDER SETTING BRIEFING SCHEDULE WITH RESPECT TO MOTIONS FOR
APPOINTMENT OF EQUITY COMMITTEE**

Upon the letters received from Alfred M. Shams [D.I. 1884] and Landon Romano [D.I. 1885] (collectively, the “Movants”) requesting that the Court appoint an equity committee (the “Equity Committee Motions”) in the above-captioned chapter 11 case of Exide Technologies (the “Debtor”); and the Court having held a scheduling hearing on the Equity Committee Motions on July 2, 2014; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

1. An evidentiary hearing on the Equity Committee Motions shall be held on July 22, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. (Eastern) (the “Hearing”).
2. Objections to the Equity Committee Motions shall be filed on or before July 14, 2014.
3. The Movants and the Debtor shall, on or before July 16, 2014, exchange and identify (a) the name and, if not previously provided, the address and telephone number of


each person each party intends to call as a witness at the Hearing, and (b) each document or other exhibit upon which each party intends to rely or offer into evidence at the Hearing.

4. All witnesses must appear in person.

5. The Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Federal Rules of Evidence, and the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware shall govern the Hearing.

6. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to the interpretation, implementation, or enforcement of the Order.
